Visitors Comments:

Resident had asked about the status of the State Audit from July 10th, no word yet

Road Report:

The roads are in good condition even with the reduced grading this past month. The culvert on Island Lake Road was plugged by beavers and the blockage was cleared and the beavers have not returned. Leo will be meeting with Little Pine Township to discuss other options for road maintenance.
